Leadership Retreat: September 30- October 1, 2022

Thirty-Three years ago, a group of Edinburg citizens involved in the Edinburg Chamber of Commerce decided leadership would improve if potential and emerging leaders had an opportunity to interact with one another and learn about the problems and issues facing the community.

From this vision, Leadership Edinburg grew to the program we have today. In August 2022, the Steering Committee will select approximately fifteen to twenty new members for Class XXXIV. Each of these individuals must express a desire for future leadership. In return, Leadership Edinburg commits to provide distinct learning environments, which will improve its member's leadership skills and opportunities.

To date over 500 people have met the Leadership Edinburg challenge. After completing the class, members have gone on to improve Edinburg by serving their committees, by serving on community boards and by working in local politics. We invite you to become part of this tradition by applying for membership in Class XXXIV.

Mandatory Kick off Retreat: During the September retreat, class members will participate in various hands-on and physical activities designed to identify various styles of leadership. Class members will analyze their own leadership styles and learn ways to communicate with other types of leaders. The class will then use their skills on several problem-solving activities.

Monthly Class Sessions: The class will meet every third (3rd) Wednesday of the month at 11:30 – a.m. to 5:30 p.m. from October 2022 through May 2023. There are a couple of exceptions for the Education session which will start at 8:00 a.m. and the March session which will meet on the 4th Wednesday. Each session will provide an outlook on the industry from experts in the field and discuss particular community issue (e.g. criminal justice, education, economic development, health care) and learn how it affects the people of Edinburg. Class members will have the opportunity to meet and interact with a wide variety of community leaders. Class members will also have the opportunity to learn from one another by sharing their own unique insights and perspectives through discussion and debate. Please be aware that one session may change to an earlier time.

Class Project: The class will identify a pressing Edinburg Chamber or Community need and design and implement a project to meet that need. Actively participating in the project allows members to strengthen their community network further. The project must be presented to LE Committee by October meeting.

Eligibility requirements: The proposed number of participants is limited; therefore, those applicants with demonstrated leadership potential related to the enhancement of Edinburg would receive priority. Eligible applicants not initially selected to participate in the program, will be placed on a waiting list for consideration at a later date. The Selection Committee will review all applications and select a class which is broadly representative of the community. There are no restrictions regarding race, sex, or religion.

Education: Begin with high school(s), then colleges(s), business trade schools and/or other specialized training.
